

Lakeland's Christmas in the Country Shopping Extravaganza

Has been held on the first Saturday in December since 2001. Initially started at Northside Antiques, (formerly Northside Lumber). Room was made to accommodate craft vendors, usually between 12 to 16, along with the Lakeland Pre-school's bake sale. Floral Magic/Summer's Past Greenhouse supplied potted poinsettias and centrepieces for sale.



After 3 years, the store could no longer provide enough room for the increasing number of vendors. With help from Leisja and Grant Horseman, owners of Floral Magic/Summer's Past Greenhouse and Laura Marchant, former owner of Vacationland News, we turned this one "place" event into a community event to include many local businesses that wanted to participate. The Craft Fair moved from my store to Jewel of the North for 1 year, then to Emma Lake Resort (McIntosh Point) until the resort closed. With the Resort no longer available to host the Christmas Fair in 2011, Laura, Leisja and I rented the Christopher Lake Legion Hall which proved to be successful. As we had our own businesses to attend to on that day, we turned the operation of the Fair over to the local Royal Purple Chapter for the next 3 years and eventually, it was taken over by the Christopher Lake Legion. The St. Christopher's Anglican Church moved their Christmas Bake sale to the same day.

Participating businesses promoted that day with in-store specials, visits with Santa, sleigh rides, wiener roasts and hot chocolate. Christmas tree sales, wreath and centrepiece classes, silent auctions, raffles, etc.. Donations were made by some participants to the Kidney Foundation and to the Lakeland & District Volunteer Fire Department. In 2006 and 2007, bus tours came from Prince Albert.

Over the past 18 years, many local businesses and organizations have participated. Hoping I haven't forgotten anyone; Sunnyside Beach Bar, Jewel of the North, Emma Lake Resort, Sunset Bay Resort, Floral Magic/Summer's Past Greenhouse, Ambrose Grocery/Bear Country Living, The Gallery House, The Green Door, Greatest Gifts Goin', Nica's Clothing, Reflections, Heritage Hotel/Aandies Tavern, Yellow Fender Catering & Eatery, St. Christopher's Anglican Church, Lake Country Restaurant, Christopher Lake Legion, Lakeland Lions Club, Lakeland Pre-school, Black Spruce Gallery, Vacationland News and Northside Antiques.

To show my appreciation to the great community that I live and work in, I have set aside one day a year for the last 18 years to welcome everyone to celebrate with me by offering store specials, hot cider, coffee and goodies and of course to help promote all the local businesses in Lakeland. Here's hoping that everyone considers shopping locally during this Christmas season. We have artisans, crafter's, home-based businesses, service clubs, churches and small businesses that need our support. Thanks to the Horsemen's and Laura Marchant for helping to see this community event achieve 18 years. Have a blessed Christmas season.
